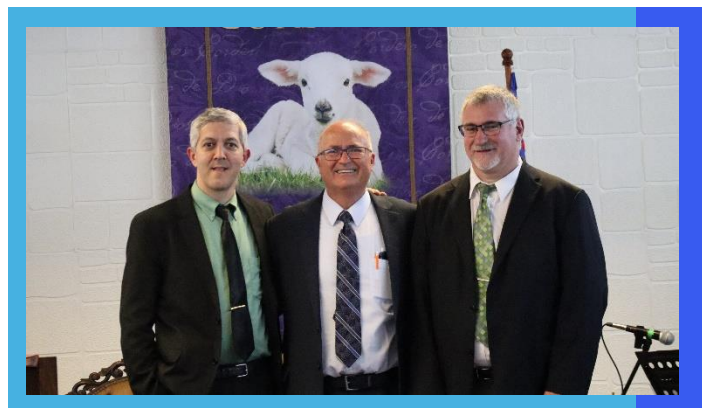
**Praises:**
