After signing the contract, we will get the keys and then get the utilities turned on. We will also begin painting, cleaning, purchasing chairs, other equipment, and printing up literature.

Let me list a few names of folks that we are praying for, and I hope that you will keep them in prayers: Rosemary and her family, her sister and her family, William and Monica, Ezekiel and Yamila and their children and Daniel, Veronica, Mariana and many other neighbors.

We are very happy that my parents, Paul and Barbara Grinstead, were able to come down and visit during the holidays. Dad is very excited about helping with the preparations for the new church.

Thanksgiving is not an Argentine holiday, so any turkey is very small and expensive. This year, instead of getting a turkey, we put an Argentine twist on things and purchased a flame grilled pork leg and started a new tradition.
