Obituary for Dr. Larry Ronald Bragg "Ron"

Larry Ronald Bragg "Ron," age 81, ended his earthly ministry and was welcomed into Heaven on Saturday, October 12, 2024. Ron is preceded in death by his mother, Lena, and his father, August Bragg, six brothers and five sisters, as well as one grandson, Trace Stephenson.

He is survived by his wife, Donna, three sons Kory Bragg (Angie), Hiram Bragg (April), and Luke Bragg (Amy) and two daughters Kelly Hook (Greg) and Hannah Townsley (Luke) as well as fifteen grandchildren and six great grandchildren who know him fondly as grandpa, gramps and g-pop. He is also survived by many nieces and nephews who call him Uncle Ron.

Ron graduated from Carthage Senior High in 1961 and then served in the US Navy. He was saved and called into the Lord's service under the ministry of Dr. J. Harold Smith in Ft. Smith, Arkansas.
