



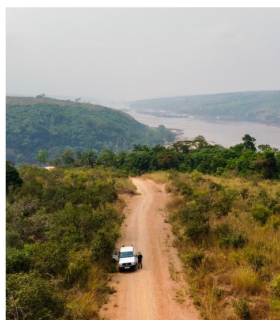
# The Caviness Family

We were also blessed to have Kelci's mom and sister stay with us for a month. It was such an encouragement to our hearts! The boys absolutely loved showing them around Congo, reading endless books and always having someone to play with them.

### Shipping container:

Earlier this year we learned that an organization in Congo is shipping in a container from the United States. They have graciously offered to allow us to purchase space on their container at a very reasonable price. This is an extremely rare opportunity and we are trying to make the most of it. With this, we have the ability to bring in items that would normally be too large or heavy to fit in a suitcase. This will allow us to bring in ministry needs such as thousands of gospel tracts, flannel graphs, teaching supplies, tools, and a portable power station. We are also excited to bring in some family items that we didn't have room for when we moved here.

### Vehicle:

After the better part of a year relying on taxis and public transportation, the Lord blessed us with a vehicle. Between our savings for a vehicle and the generosity of our sending church, we were able to buy a truck that will serve our family and ministry for many years!

### Traveling:

I have four or five trips planned in the coming few months. Several will be to survey different regions of Congo with the purpose of making contacts and seeking to evaluate the potential for future ministry. I will also be traveling to Ivory Coast for a BIMI field conference. Please pray for safety, direction and open doors!
