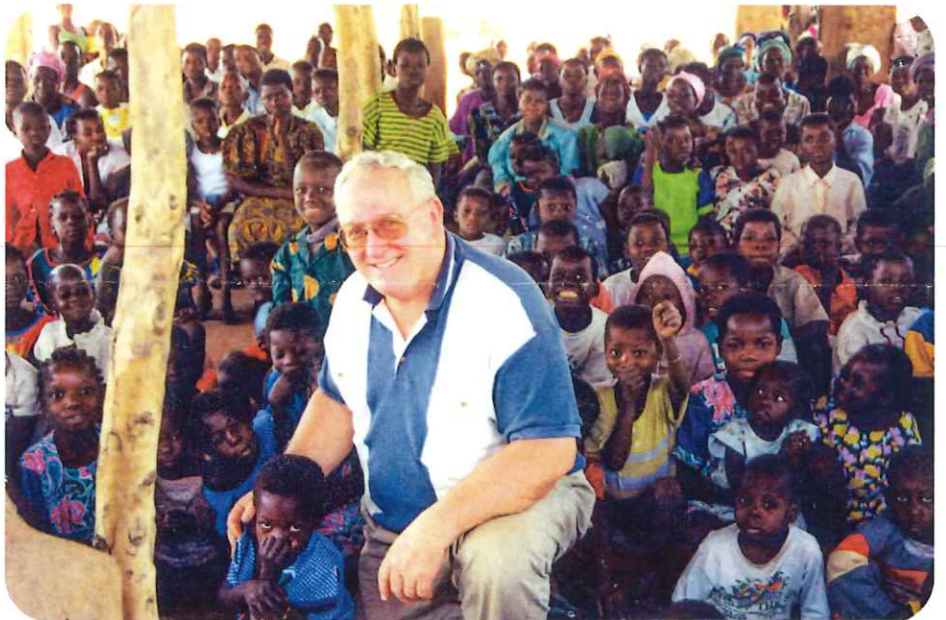

We could buy any drug over the counter so I got some and took it. Needless to say, the pain left. From time to time in my life I have felt pain in my lower right side but it always left. Now at 81 it was time to take care of it. I had no pain and the Lord gave me a wonderful opportunity to share Him with so many. I gave eight of my books away and even one to my surgeon. One young lady said that she had been saved only one year and she was so hungry for the things of the Lord. I told her to call or come to church where I go if she needed to talk and mailed her one of my books. About three years ago Ron almost died in the hospital and a doctor was flown in from Atlanta, Georgia, to work in the hospital at that time. She was from Nigeria and she literally saved his life. Now here I am in the hospital needing surgery and the surgeon's parents passed away in Ghana. She was born in Africa, reared in England and practicing in Joplin, Missouri. God used us to be a blessing and help to the African continent for 50 years and now God is bringing Africans to us here in the States to help us!

Thank you again for your love, continued support and prayers! God is taking good care of me and He is using many of you to help with that.
