The ministries in Haiti continue to move forward. Desroulins Independent Baptist Church is growing under national leadership. Desroulins Independent Baptist School is entering the final months of this school year and Grace Baptist Bible Institute has an enrollment of over 80 men.

On the last day of March, Kerri and I traveled to the Dominican Republic to spend five days with the missionaries serving there. What a privilege it was to spend the day together with many missionary families. Kerri and I were able to have a special time with the children. As a missionary



kid myself, I recognize the value in spending time with other missionary kids.



Another highlight was visiting in the North Coast Baptist Church, which has several Haitians attending their church services. I was able to have a separate preaching service in Creole—my first language!

The missionaries in the Dominican Republic are involved in deaf ministries, Christian

schools, Bible Institutes, youth camps, and church reproduction. Praise the Lord for hundreds who made professions of salvation and many that followed the Lord

in believers' baptism! A national pastor has a ministry called "The Love Kitchen" that supplies weekly meals to the local jail, and he uses that opportunity to preach and teach the Gospel. Please pray with us for more laborers.
