Manny talked him throughout the flight and was able to witness to him. Another time, we began talking to a Native man in Louisiana, wondering if he was Navajo. When Manny mentioned that he had Navajo friends, he immediately began quizzing us on our Navajo pronunciation (we didn't pass). Though he was hardened to the Gospel, we were glad to show him Christ's love and prayed that we had planted a seed.
