This coming fall, we are planning on doing a community mail out, with our goal being to get a piece of Gospel literature in every mailbox in Trenton. We are sending out a little flyer that tells the story of John 3:16. The flyer also includes a link to a video presentation of the Gospel. Please pray that hearts will be receptive to the message. Our church folks have already begun to give special offerings toward this project.

During the month of March, our family was able to travel to Quebec City for a week to visit with my wife's side of the family. We had not been able to visit with her siblings and their families in nearly four years. Although it was a very busy week, with nearly 30 of us together, we left feeling refreshed and recharged. Our kids had a great time with their cousins, who they rarely get to see due to distance.

We continue to see visitors come out to our services. One of these visitors is a young lady named Alisha, who attended for the first time last month. Alisha grew up Catholic, and had some questions about baptism. Through conversation it became very clear to me that she is not yet saved.
