I am writing this letter from Africa again! One of my joys as a field director is helping new missionaries visit the field and get them established on the Continent. The past two months have been



exciting as I have assisted two new missionaries as they have visited Africa and prayerfully considered where God would have them serve. The first couple is looking at serving in the Democratic Republic of Congo and reaching primarily the pygmy tribes of that country who live near the border of Uganda. The second family is prayerfully considering the small nation of Rwanda. As many of you will remember, that country faced a terrible genocide back in 1994 where thousands were killed. However, there are very few missionaries who have worked in this needy country. As a matter of fact, currently there are no Baptist church planters (of any kind) living in that country. The need could never be more than now!

While on these trips, I was also able to visit our former ministries in Kenya and host a pastors' conference for all the national churches that have been a part of our ministry through the years.
