CELEBRATIONS

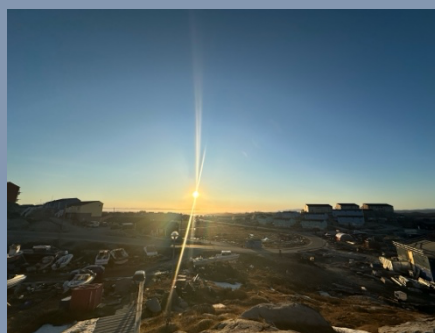

Everyday things seem more normal to us now than they did two years ago. We're even noticing adjustment to the temperature! A sunny 40° day now feels much warmer and more like a summer day.

We also celebrated the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We thank the Lord for blessing through the music program and the preaching on Easter Sunday. Most of the regulars attended and there was also a tourist couple who attended in the English service.

GREENLANDIC CLASSES

As we have mentioned before, there has not been a whole lot of helps in learning this difficult language. For quite some time, we have been working through an online video class that the government offers. While this class has been helpful, it has also left us with many questions, questions left unanswered without a live teacher to ask. This has made it difficult to

really make significant progress. We are praising the Lord though that we have been able to find a Greenlandic teacher in Nuuk who has now started offering some online classes! Gage was able to enroll in this 6-week class and it has been a great help and blessing having a teacher these past number of weeks. We want to thank each of you who have been praying for our language acquisition. We still have a long way to go but so thankful for the Lord's provision and help along the way!
