Be Instant In Season and Out Of Season!

"Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long suffering and doctrine" (2Timothy 4:2)

There are seasons of ministry which are more fruitful than others. In the jungles of the Amazon the rainy season comes to a close in May, which is when we kick off our season of Amazon Connect Trips! The significance of this time of year cannot be understated, because with the rivers up and often overflowing, we are able to travel by boat into remote villages otherwise only accessible by foot and days of jungle hiking. The Amazon basin holds over 40 million people and the largest concentration of uncontacted tribes anywhere in the world. These groups are uncontacted primarily due to the difficulty in accessing these remote regions and the often reluctance of the villagers to welcome outsiders. We began Amazon For Christ twenty years ago with the expressed purpose of *"striving to preach where Christ is not named"*. One of our primary tools in accomplishing this goal is the use of mobile medical clinics. The medical aspect opens doors to villages otherwise closed to outsiders, which gives our evangelistic team and national pastors an open door to present the gospel. The goal is to eventually see a church plant in the villages. We rejoice that in these twenty years God has allowed us to see a harvest of souls and churches planted in the Amazon beyond Brazil into Colombia, Peru, Bolivia, Guyana and next month we will be going to Suriname to help missionaries, Mark & Emily Mariner, plant their first church. What each of these countries have in common is the **AMAZON** jungle. This season our teams have already accomplished much for Christ.

Candidate School at BIMI in 2025. Every June we gather at the BIMI World Mission Center to teach and screen the new missionary candidates. We rejoice that God is still sending laborers into the harvest. This year we had 48 total missionary candidates go through our training classes and commissioned to take the gospel into the harvest. Yet Christ still exhorts every Christian to *"pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest that He would send forth laborers into His harvest fields"*.

SMART Internship Program Launched in 2025. This past year we were burdened to help develop an effective ministry to mentor young people interested in missions and ministry. God put the same burdened on the hearts of others in our leadership, which has resulted in **BIMI SMART**. The acronym is **Strategic Mentorship And Reality Training**. Last week we had our first intern launch out to Brazil, where she will be interning with missionary Bethany Thompson and using her skills as a graphic designer at the Christian School publishing house. This facility allows us to store medicine and supplies in a climatized environment. And it provides a collection location where we can stage the trips before traveling to the Amazon.
