In May, our son Andy bought Linda a reclining standing bicycle to help with her exercises for her Parkinson's. Two workers came with the delivery to put it together. Both men were from Eastern Europe (one from Montenegro and the other from Serbia). As they worked in the house, I began sharing the Gospel with them. By the time the bicycle was set up, both men had prayed and asked the Lord to save them. What a blessing!

Our work in West Africa continues. We are coming into the time of our VBS programs as well as soulwinning seminars. Pastor Samson continues the preparation for his 25th Anniversary service (in 2026). We are finishing his building project and trust it will be ready for that special service next year. Our prison work continues, we were able to do our Easter Breakfast and had over 1000 inmates and staff make professions of faith. We also were able to provide funds for several churches to have an Easter Monday activity.

I would ask that you continue to pray for Linda, she has had a rough go in May and the start of June. Linda was in the hospital for 12 days in May. Her blood levels were problematic along with an infection in her hip (which was replaced 2 years ago). She had to have another surgery on the hip to drain the infection and is home now with 6 weeks of antibiotic therapy. Needless to say, added to her Parkinson's, she has been challenged with her physical needs. Thanks so much for praying. Pray for our upcoming programs (youth, children and University seminars). Also pray as we continue to see progress in our new church plant in Nigeria. I am grateful for your prayers and support for our ministry over 4 decades. GOD HAS BEEN GOOD!
