We were able to be together a few times as my wife and I took a trip to Huancayo in July to celebrate our 30th wedding

anniversary. We were invited to preach in a missions conference in Huancayo for a week, as well. We were also able to celebrate Perú's independence day with family on July 28 in Huancayo.

Our church in Oxapampa



received visitors from churches on the coast to help us in the ministry. We continue to pray that God would send us laborers to assist us in establishing this church, as well as for the church to have its own property. We thank those who have donated specifically for the purchase of land and ask you to continue to pray that God will provide and give us wisdom.

God has us establishing Mount Calvary Baptist Church in an area that is growing rapidly. The city of Oxapampa just celebrated its 134th anniversary, with many visitors overcrowding the area. Oxapampa has a lot of construction taking place from hotels, open markets, new and expanding grocery stores, etc. We are seeing continued growth with road access to bring in supplies and the rumor of getting an airport near our area in the future.

Our church received good news of a previous family returning to the church after leaving for medical attention in a bigger city for six months. Perú churches will celebrate many important things in the month of September, such as the anniversary of the Bible translation into Spanish, a youth day and also a family day.



Family update: A new member of our family was added as an anniversary gift. It's a new kitten we named "CoCo." Our children have started classes again. Matthew teaches many junior high and high school classes in a Christian school in Vermont. Nathan, Rebecca and Katie continue to work hard in their jobs, along with classes at Maranatha. Katie was able to take her church

missions trip to South Korea and was encouraged by the opportunity to serve God in the churches. Nisha and I have had inconveniences these last two months, including the loss of electricity and water at times and minor sicknesses, but one thing in particular happened to me that has affected our lives. I pulled a muscle in the back of my knee that became very swollen. It would not heal and continued to get worse. After receiving an ultrasound, the doctor revealed that the muscle was damaged and would need special attention. He said not to use it at all for a week, as well as take medication and use crutches for six to nine weeks for it to heal. I did my best for a few days but without helpers in the church I needed to continue with church services. It has now been eight weeks, and I'm still needing crutches. Please pray that my knee heals soon. I will be having another doctor's visit soon.
