## Greetings from South Africa,

The last few months have been a mixture of both joys and sorrows, beginning with funerals just a week apart at both churches. At Solid Rock Baptist Church, a lady named Clara, who has attended the church for many, many years, went to be with the Lord. She was well known, and the funeral was well attended by both her family and friends, many of whom used to attend the church. God blessed, and gave great liberty in preaching on Heaven and Hell both being prepared places, and asking the question "Which one is prepared for you?" As we have watched them faithfully serving the Lord, God has shown that it is time to ordain them and call them as Assistant Pastors. It is a great joy and blessing to see God's hand on their lives, and we are excited for what God will do as we labour together. Please pray for them, and perhaps even consider supporting them, that they might be able to devote more of their time into ministry.
