We apologize that this letter is going out a little delayed! Our son, Sam, came down with Guillian Barre Syndrome in September and Brenda went up to help with their 2 babies while his wife, Robyn, juggled many things. Yesterday he came home from rehabilitation and is now able to walk with a cane. Please pray for him as he works to gain back total function. Full recuperation takes months.

These have been very fruitful months of ministry for us. The Lord has guided our church to continue the ministry of preaching in local schools and passing out Bibles and rice. We had a great team of people from Faro working together in this ministry during July and August. The response has been very good with many praying to receive Christ and grateful to have their own copy of God's Word!

September 13th we celebrated Children's Day at the church and had over 100 children and parents plus 20 or so workers from Faro. The youth worked hard learning puppets, balloon, and face art in order to make the day fun for the children, as well as prepared themselves to give the Gospel. 2 children came forward to receive Christ that day. These have been excellent times of mobilizing the church and training all that are involved.

In July, Celbin, a young man 15 years old, was baptized. He had been saved at camp earlier in the year. Our youth department is growing and eager to serve inside and outside services, which is a real blessing.

Please pray for the church in our absence as we are now on furlough through the end of December. We have had 3 new Christian families join recently and they are already a big blessing. Pray for continued unity and growth during this time.

And we appreciate your prayers for our travels as well! We will be in Florida, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Alabama, Georgia, and Texas.
