Dear Prayer Partners,

We thank you for your continued prayers for our family. We have made it safely to the States; and, so far, everything is going well. We will all be here for a total of about six weeks, during which time, we'll be in four missions conferences and one Sunday meeting as we begin to give churches an update on our ministry. By mid-November, I (Nathan) will return to Chile without the rest of the family. Flights for all eight of us are not cheap, and the kids will enjoy their first Christmas in the States with their grandparents. Christine should have plenty of help from the grandparents in my absence. While back in Chile, I'll set some affairs in order, offer further guidance for the men who will lead the churches in my absence, and rejoin the family in the States in early January. We'll travel full time beginning in February and look forward to seeing most of you personally to thank you for all that you have done for us and for our Lord.

So far, we have seen God's hand blessing us all along the way. Just the fact that we made it to the States without missing a flight, losing a bag, or anyone getting sick is evidence enough of God's grace. God also allowed us to purchase a 2015 12-passenger Chevy Express before we landed, so that we would have transportation ready for us. Please pray that it would accomplish the task of carrying our family everywhere we go. Our mechanic gave it a thorough examination and found it to be in top shape, but we will pray for its safety every day.

Right before we left Chile, God reminded us why we are in Chile. María Estela is a faithful church member. Her husband, Alejandro Lopez, is lost and we've asked you to pray for him many times, as we prayed for him almost daily. She approached me a few weeks ago and said that she couldn't stand living with him any longer. He had a lot of problems in his extended family and work, and those problems drove him to depression and alcohol; and she just couldn't tolerate the way he was. She told me he needed to get saved and asked if I could please come share the gospel with him. To make a long story short, she agreed to invite me to dinner and not tell him, or else he might purposely not be home at dinnertime. Once dinner was over, he opened up his heart to me, admitted he was a sinner headed to hell, and called on Jesus to save him from his sins. God is so good! I'll have to look back at the prayer list and see who else we have repeatedly asked you to pray for that hasn't gotten saved, but I know Emilio, Carla, Miguel, and now Alejandro Lopez were mentioned frequently. The only other one that stands out is Enrique, Valeria's husband, and maybe Daniel, Ninoska's husband. Please keep praying for the lost as God is still saving sinners, even the hard hearted, stubborn and rebellious ones!

Last, please pray for our family. Getting situated in the States has been a bit of a challenge, as we are essentially living out of suitcases until we get organized living in the grandparents' houses. Throw in travelling to missions conferences, and doing it with six kids, and I think you can understand how the parents might be a little stressed right now. We praise the Lord for good health, and pray that God would continue to protect our health. On that note, Sam broke his arm about three weeks before we came to the States. We'll find out this week if the cast can come off, or if he needs further surgery, and we greatly appreciate your prayers for his healing.
