We send you warm greetings from the Dominican Republic. Our Lord is blessing our family and our church in a great way.

I want to say thank you so much for those who prayed for and/or sent us a special offering for our camp program. This year there were 207 campers, 8 saved, 2 baptized, and 21 surrendered to serve the Lord full time. Thank you for helping make this time a great success. God bless you!

Praise the Lord that two weeks ago we started church number 15 in an area called El Admirante, A couple from Pastor José Manuel's church in Los Frailes will be pastoring this work. Please pray for Brother Santos and Sister Gloria as they serve the Lord in this new area. Pastor José Manuel is looking at a couple of other new areas where he would like to start a new church soon as well.

A couple of weeks ago, during our Saturday Soulwinning time, the Lord gave me the privilege of sharing the gospel with 4 young baseball players. Praise the Lord, they all got saved. They are Joel – 14 years old, Yariel – 12 years old, Daniel – 16 years old, and Yadiel – 11 years old. The next week the Lord allowed me to win a young man I have known for years named Edwin to the Lord. He is 30 years old. He lives in the neighborhood behind our church.

This coming Sunday, the 28th is the 28th Church Anniversary of our church in Quita Sueño. Our people work very hard and pray very hard each year seeking for the Lord to give us a great day of services. We have a special day for the kids in the morning with preaching, great music, ice cream, and a lot of other special things. Then we concentrate on a special service for the adults and teenagers in the evening. In the past we have usually had around 1,000 people, more or less come, with a good number of professions of faith and baptisms. We usually average around 200-250 for our weekly evening services, so the bigger attendance is usually just for the anniversary. Please pray that God would give us fruit that remains.

God is also blessing our Bible Institute for this semester. There are 20 students who are taking classes. Thank you for helping make all these things possible with you faithful friendship and support. God bless you!
