The young adults in the church stepped up to host this camp for the teens, and we are thankful for every one of those volunteers. The teens have been giving their testimonies of how God worked in their hearts- many decided to never turn back to their old worldly ways and to take these “vows” they made to the Lord more earnestly.



In the past year, we had the privilege of attending Spiritual Leadership Conference Asia, with many of our church family. Our young people had an opportunity to worship the Lord among thousands of believers and some of them surrendered their lives to God's calling.
