One of the religions that seems to be growing rapidly in Gulu is the Latter-Day Saints. They now have three meeting houses around Gulu. Recently, one of our men went out during our Saturday morning soul-winning time. He was able to preach the gospel to some people who were on their way to one of these meeting houses. Although those people didn't get saved, he was able to plant the seed of the gospel. Please pray that we will be able to be a light to people who have been deceived by the growing influence of the Latter-Day Saints in Gulu.

Radio Station

In our last prayer letter, we mentioned that to stay compliant with Uganda Communication Commission we need \$8200. We praise the Lord that need has been met! However, our current transmitter is reaching the end of its life. We're experiencing some issues with it; but praise the Lord that so far we've been able to remain on air! It's a matter of time until we need to purchase a new one, though. New transmitters are around \$15,000. Please pray that we will be able to remain on air with our existing transmitter until we can purchase a new one. We cannot purchase them here in Uganda. The one we're looking at will need to be purchased from Canada and brought over after one of our trips we'll be making to the States over the next couple of years.

Furlough Plans

Our oldest son Andrew will be getting married in December, so we'll be making a quick one-month trip back to the States for that. Since we're actually due for a furlough, we're working on putting a new presentation together. We'll do a couple of meetings in December, but we're not sure yet about the rest of furlough as we'll have to work around the various events in our kids' lives. Please pray for wisdom as we plan this next furlough!
