We have had many visitors coming to our church recently. Some are from our island, and others are visiting family or friends. Either way, there is evidence that God is at work in people's hearts as they are hearing the simple, saving Gospel, many for the first time in their life. Two Filippinos have been attending faithfully, even though they have a Catholic background. A local lady and her son have been attending regularly. Florence, from another island, visited family on our island and came to our church, saying afterwards, concerning the simple plan of the Gospel, "It was certainly something to make me think". She is from a church of God of prophecy. It reminded me of the phrase, "Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian." Please pray for her salvation, and many others as well.

Many people who hear the Gospel - I will never know if they trust Jesus as their Saviour or not, as they come and go, living elsewhere. But, regardless, the seed has been sown. We give them to the Lord's hands Who is able to bring others into their life who will water the seed, as it is God Who ultimately gives the increase. We are confident that His Word never returns void, but it will accomplish that which He pleases, and it will prosper in the thing whereto He sent it.

Two children were saved in Sunday School recently. They are like many who hear the Gospel from us, make a profession of faith, continue a little while, but who hear a false gospel almost daily from others. At school, they will hear a false gospel given by various pastors during morning devotions. Likewise, their teachers will teach that same false gospel during the day. When the child gets home, they hear that same false gospel from their guardian. It's difficult to get people grounded in the truth here as they are so unfaithful to church, and it's impossible to visit everybody we have dealt with. Since May 2025, the electric company has been having trouble with weekly hours-long blackouts, and unpredictable brownouts. The blackouts come at all hours of the day and night. When the power goes out at night, it gets real hot real fast and becomes impossible to sleep. The brownouts have destroyed several of our appliances, including our well pump, oven, refrigerator, and a few other small electronics. We have tried brown-out protectors, but they don't seem to help. We are looking to raise \$10,000 for a small solar system to put some fans and a few small appliances on it. We are not looking to run ac's on solar, but this will help to cool us off in this oppressive heat. Please pray about helping us with this need.
