We pray each of you has had a blessed Christmas and a wonderful start to 2026! Our last update was a video showing among other things, the progress that had been made on the building. Thank you again for those who sent funds for those projects. Much was accomplished and the work continues on, putting the finishing touches on the added rooms.

This past Sunday we celebrated the First Anniversary of Solid Rock Baptist Church of Belize. What a tremendous blessing that was!! There were almost 70 people from the area that came as well as the church family of Faith Baptist Church of Belmopan, pastored by missionary Jonathan Shertzer. Together with their 40 or so people from their church, we fit over 100 into our auditorium! We were not expecting so many people, and it was a bit cozy in there, but we fit! And it was awesome! Hearing the singing voices of all those people was truly a gift from God!! During a Praise and Prayer Request time, what a blessing it was to hear many of them offer up praise to the Lord of their gratefulness to Him for this church that He is building in their community, and what a blessing the past year has been to them and their families. There are no words, my friends, but Praise GOD-Great things He hath done!

It's been a busy season. We had our first Christmas services. One precious lady said that the Christmas Eve service was the hi-light of her Christmas. The Sunday School children did their first Christmas play. We've continued to see a number of visitors come out through the end of the year. Some because of neighbours or family inviting them, others saw the church sign and wanted to check it out, others are preparing to move to the country and are looking for a good church. Please pray for each of these that if God desires them to find their church home here that He would work in their lives to accomplish that. And if they're not saved, that they'd get that settled and then grow in Him.

As usual, the work to reach Belize is not confined to just our community, I had the privilege to help out a couple of other missionaries in our district (like a province or state) One is preparing to start a school, and has undertaken a building project for that. Helping pour cement a couple of times is a way I've been able to help. Another missionary has purchased a property for their future ministry site and needed a roof replaced on the existing structure on the property. Shout out to the young people out there...if you've ever wondered how God is going to use what He currently has you doing, be patient. I wondered the same thing about years of working with concrete and steel roofing, and now, those skills are some of the biggest assets I have in the ministry here.

Immigration update, we were able to get our permanent residency paperwork submitted, finally! We, as well, were able to have the initial interview. There are still several more steps and approvals needed. Please continue to pray!




