We want to express our sincere gratitude for your faithful prayers and generous support. By God’s grace and through your partnership, we have now raised approximately 95% of the funds needed for the land purchase and the first phase of construction for our new ministry facility. This is a significant milestone, and we praise the Lord for His provision and your participation.

With the land purchase and initial building phase nearly complete, we are now prayerfully working toward the next stage of property development, which includes essential site preparation and infrastructure. We are building on an old rice field and will need to raise the level of the land. We are asking the Lord to move a mountain and place it on our land. While much has already been accomplished, there is still a need as we move forward, and we value your continued prayers as the Lord directs the remaining resources.

Thank you for standing with us, not only financially, but spiritually as co-laborers in the work God is doing here. Your partnership is making a lasting impact for the gospel.

## School Outreaches

Christmas provides a unique opportunity in Thailand for outreach. Schools and other community centers are open to programs put on by the church during this season. This year, Sila Baptist Church put on programs at three local elementary schools. Two of the schools are within walking distance of the church, and we have students from church at all three schools. We played games, sang songs, and most importantly, shared the gospel - the wonderful news of the Savior coming to earth.

The culmination of our Christmas season outreaches is Christmas Sunday. The Friday night before, we went caroling at our local market and passed out many invitations to our services. We had a packed house. While we had many visitors from our school outreach, and market outreach, we also had many visitors coming with church members. Please pray for Bobby's mom and Milk's mom, that are not yet believers. They came and clearly heard the gospel on Christmas Sunday. Many of our church members are the only Christians in their family and they faithfully pray for mothers, fathers, and extended family members to come to know Christ.

As we look back on this year, one of the biggest blessings is seeing Toey and Milk get married on December 26th. Toey's dad is a pastor in Lampang. Toey began interning at Sila over five years ago. Over the years, his growth in the Lord has been evident. Last year, Toey was installed as an assistant pastor at Sila Baptist Church. He serves in many various capacities, but maybe most importantly, has headed up discipleship for the young men of the church.

Milk came to Christ years ago as a young teen from the witness of our one our church members, Pia. After years out of church, Milk came to Sila several years ago. It has been amazing to see the Lord work in and through her life. Milk has taken responsibility for the teen girls Sunday school class. Milk is the only believer in her family.

Milk and Toey got married the day after Christmas at the church. They specifically structured the wedding ceremony to clearly be a witness to Milk's unsaved family members. For many of the 300 people that attended, this was the only time they had ever been in a Christian service or a church. Aajarn Apisit, Toey's dad, spoke about Christ and the church. Aajarn Srithone gave a challenge to them as they begin a Christian marriage.

At the beginning of 2026, Toey will begin teaching the Adult Bible class on Sunday mornings.
