Our church bus driver has recently brought over his family from Haiti. He has a wife and two teenage daughters. He asked me to witness to his daughters, and, having been able to witness to them individually, one of them has trusted Christ as her Saviour. Please pray for her to grow in the knowledge and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Meanwhile, we are praying that the other daughter gets saved as well.

A couple children in Sunday School have also prayed to get saved recently. Amy works really hard with them, teaching them the simple plan of salvation. It's hard to teach anything more than that because any given child may only attend once or twice a month. Please pray for Amy as she deals with that, and pray for the children and their families to get saved and be faithful to hear God's Word.

A Filipino family has recently been attending our church services. The wife and daughter live on our island, but the husband lives and works on another island. Occasionally, they all attend together. Please pray for us to have opportunities to witness to them as they run away very quickly at the end of the service, and have very busy schedules during the week. The Filipinos are hard to reach as they are either working hard or partying hard, but we are praying this gives the gospel a road into the Filipino community here.

The brownouts and blackouts on our island continue every weekend. We wanted to say a special thank you to the churches who have given sacrificially toward our solar project. So far, we have raised \$3,541 and are trying to reach a goal of \$10,000. This would help us to run the fans at night so we can sleep better, and cool off from the intense heat during the day, while protecting some of our appliances from being exposed to the unstable electrical grid.

A couple of years ago, Amy led an Englander to the Lord. This lady comes and goes, but she has recently fallen on some very hard personal times. She is beginning to realize how desperately she "needs God", not just for salvation, but for getting from one day to another. Please pray for this woman to get to the Lord better. We never know how the Lord will use us, but it is blessing seeing that we have a global impact, and to see fruit that lasts.
