Andrew's Wedding

We are so thankful for the special time we had in the States over the month of December. The Lord gave us smooth travels and great health during that month! We enjoyed connecting with family that we haven't seen in a long time and getting to know Hannah, our new daughter-in-law. It was a busy time, and Andrew and Hannah's wedding was so



beautiful, and it gave all glory to God! We praise the Lord for what He is doing in their lives! Please pray for them as they begin their lives together.

This was a new experience for several of our kids who have never been to an American wedding. Please pray especially for Susanna, who will soon be graduating from high school, as she makes decisions for the future that she'll follow God with her life.

While we were in America, we were also able to begin visiting churches. We plan to continue visiting churches at the end of July, when we'll return to the States for a couple of months to help Susanna get adjusted to life in the States. Also, we appreciate prayer for new support, especially for the radio station. Please pray that God will use us as we begin to connect again in-person with different churches through this unique furlough time.

December's Ministries

While we were in America, a couple of events happened at Kica Baptist Church in our absence. First, 28 of our teens went to a 4-day youth camp in Arua and seven of our children went to a children's camp in Gulu. During the teen camp one young man, Joshua, surrendered his life to do whatever God wants him to do! We praise the Lord for other decisions that were made, as well.

Second, the church had their annual missions conference in December. We praise the Lord for Pastor Elly who preached and the approximately \$400 that was pledged for Faith Promise! This is especially encouraging because we weren't around for this event.

January's Bible School

In the block class we had immediately upon returning to Gulu in January, Brother Axis taught Bible Interpretation and Pastor Patrick taught Doctrines 1. It's a blessing for us to see these men do a great job teaching the class even though we were not there for the first couple days of it. Please pray for the 25 students who attended. Our numbers were lower this time because we had to move the class to an earlier week due to the presidential elections that were also held in January. We'll also begin a semester of Bible college the first week of February. Please pray for two new men who will be joining us from a couple of our village churches, Victor and Kenneth.

Praise and Prayer

- We praise the Lord that the Ugandan presidential elections in January were peaceful! Although we had four days without Internet and there were a few scattered riots, it went much more smoothly than many were expecting. President Museveni was re-elected at the age of 81. He's been our president here for 40 years.

- Please keep praying as we are still waiting for the final approval to renew our five-year operating radio license. This has been a long process; please pray this will happen quickly!
