Santa Marta Update

Our year got off to a running start again with VBS in Santa Marta the first week of January. We were blessed to have about a dozen workers from our church in Rionegro travel 16 hours in our church bus to help for the week. While we only had about a dozen kids from the city on the first night, God worked mightily and blessed our efforts to invite visitors. The last two nights were packed with around 100 people crammed into the garage area and they all heard the gospel. After seeing the great need for better transportation, we decided to leave our church bus with the Duartes to use in brining these precious children to church. Every week now they continue to see many ride the bus to church and hear the gospel. We are praying now about purchasing a second church bus/van as we now are without one in Rionegro.

Victory Baptist Seminary is now International

We are excited that students from seven other countries are now studying in our Seminary. All of our classes are available online and the classes that I teach in person every week are streamed live for the online students. There are now multiple churches in Ecuador that meet on Tuesday nights with their pastors and then watch the classes live and can even ask questions. We are excited to see how God continues to use this ministry in the future to train laborers not only in Colombia but throughout Latin America!

Ministry update in Rionegro

Our church in Rionegro continues to do well and there is always something going on in ministry. The church is very consistently breaking 100 in attendance on Sundays and we look forward to our auditorium expansion as soon as the building permits are approved by the government. Souls are being saved, baptized, and added to the church on a very consistent basis. We are also excited to have a new BIMI missionary couple (the Reisingers) working with us!
