Dear Praying Friends,

It has been a blessing to go through the book of I John on Sundays with the believers here. We have had some great discussions about life-changing truths. Please keep praying for our believer friends here to grow and follow Christ. We will be holding a ladies' meeting this Friday evening (Feb. 27th). Sarah has invited quite a few lady friends of hers from the community. Please pray that God would bring our own church ladies as well as several visitors, and that He would give Sarah strength and wisdom to teach them.

Thank you for praying for the different outreach opportunities we are starting up here. The leadership at the high school approved our plan for a youth group meeting with Bible teaching. We are waiting for the local school district approval process to go through, but it looks like this will happen. This agreement will allow us to hold the youth meeting at the school itself. Please pray that this goes through and that God would allow us to meet the spiritual needs of these young people.

We also received approval for our ministry at the local children's home. We are just waiting for the county government to complete the paperwork. This will allow us to have a children's Bible club with some of the same kids that are friends with Andrew at school. It will be a unique opportunity for our kids to be involved in ministry. We can also minister to the young mothers who live at this home with their infant children.

I met with the principal at Andrew's school a few weeks ago, and he agreed to let us rent one of their large room once a week to hold a training program for young children with special needs. We already have a few families interested in joining us. This will begin next Wednesday. Please pray that God would give us families that we can connect with spiritually through this program.

Sarah has had a good time with her growing group of junior-high kids on Fridays in our home. She has been getting to know them and is beginning to start more serious conversations with them. Please pray for Eszti and her friends that they would understand the gospel clearly and embrace the truth.

Another recent blessing is that a local hotel agreed to let Andrew and I come in one morning a week for swimming lessons free of charge. His schoolteachers didn't think it would be a good idea for him to join the class swimming instruction because of the special attention he needs. This way I can help Andrew individually learn how to swim. He really enjoys it!

Please continue to pray for the sale of our home in Nyíregyháza. We haven't had anyone look at the house since December of last year, and I don't know that there is anything I can do to make it sell faster. We have already brought the price down several times. The house we are

currently renting has recently been put up for sale. It seems ideal if we could sell our other house and then buy this current one. However, if someone else comes along and purchases it before we can, then we would have to look for another place. House rental properties are very scarce here in this city. The Lord knows best.
