We treasure the conversations that begin to arise over meals shared, and after services. We pray for depth in those conversations and clarity as we witness. Pray for those that have heard, but have not yet trusted Christ.

The land purchase has been finalized. We're thankful for no major problems as the paperwork and transfers were completed. The next steps are a survey, building a bridge, and putting in fill dirt. The fill dirt will need to sit for 6-9 months before construction can begin. During that time, we will finalize building plans, and secure permits. Pray for favor for the local community as many approvals are needed.
