The attendant didn't know what happened to it either.

We contacted the police in Winnipeg. It took two weeks, but the car was finally located and towed to Winkler. No damage was done.

We prayed for the person(s) salvation who stole the vehicle. We also left two Bibles in the car and how to get to heaven tracts. Maybe they read them, although they were still in the vehicle when the car was found by the police.



### THE TAXI

In the meantime, to get back to Winkler from Winnipeg, we had to take a cab that was parked at the hospital and drove 116 km back to Winkler - about 1.30 hrs. The driver wanted \$230.00, which we felt was a bit much, but we were able to witness to him and gave him a tract.



### TORN AWAY

Finally, arriving home from Winnipeg and dropped off by the taxi, we walked up to our front door to find our scripture sign ripped off—torn away deliberately. The sign read: "AS FOR ME AND MY HOUSE, WE WILL SERVE THE LORD."

Who would do this? We live in a fairly religious area. Our hearts were broken after the ordeal in Winnipeg, only to come home to the sign gone.

Someone hates the Word of God...amen? I believe much of this is due to our heart's desire to reach the Jews everywhere with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
