We're home from Bolivia. It was a wonderful trip! Each morning after breakfast, the team had a short but sweet devotional time. One of our men compared the rebuilding of the walls in Nehemiah to what we do. On the majority of our projects, we come in, do our part, & leave. Sometimes, another group precedes or follows us. Often, we don't get to see the end results. In Nehemiah, some men worked on the sheep gate while others worked on the dung gate & so on. Each gate (12 in total) was an important part of the project, but it was only a part. The reason the build was successful was because the people had the same goal in mind – **to do their part, glorify God & to see His work furthered.** Perhaps, one day in Heaven, we will see the end results of our work. Until then, we thank God for those who come beside us & gladly do their part for the glory of God & the furtherance of the Gospel!
