The summer season is upon us. I am currently sitting outside typing this prayer letter. The flowers are blooming and the birds are singing. The summer season is a busy time for ministry here. We have several outreaches planned, as well as some baptisms. Our church currently does not have a baptismal tank, so we take advantage of the warmer weather. We go to a river not far from our church building called Mountain Brook and hold a baptismal service at a well known place in the community. The baptism is planned for July 12. We currently have 3 young people, and two adults who will be following the Lord in believers baptism. Because our area is predominately Roman Catholic, there is always curiosity about Baptism. We have had neighbours come to watch as well as people at the river who always seem to be curious. It is a wonderful testimony. One of the men from our last prayer letter named André, is following the Lord in baptism. Also please pray for boldness for a young lady named Ronnie who is seeking to be baptized. She is facing hardships from her Roman Catholic family for taking this step.

Our children's ministries continue to bring in new attendees. Our Kings Kids program finished strong in May. We will be holding a Summer Bible Club in July. The Lord has recently put us in contact with new children in our neighbourhood, and we are praying that we can get them to the Bible Club this summer.

In August our church is planning a building project. We will be replacing all of our auditorium windows and installing siding/insulation on the outside of the building. It is going to be a good size project, so please pray for the work to go well.

The church has seen record attendance in recent Sunday services. There does seem to be a hunger for spiritual truth in many peoples hearts in our area. We are praying most of all for spiritual growth and salvation for those that come through the doors.
