Once again, we're excited to get to share a little of what God is doing here in Belize. Thank you for partnering with us through prayer, communication and financial support. We could not be here doing what we do without you.

For the past six weeks, I've been able to fill in and preach at another church. Jason joined me in doing some special music as well. It was a blessing to be able to serve this church family that was without a pastor for a couple of months, as well as get to know a number of Belizeans. As a missionary, I am always striving to learn more about the different cultures here, especially in regards to how they view and process spiritual things. So in addition to the blessing of just getting to meet and minister to people, this was an excellent opportunity to see the inner workings of another church in our general area.

We've had some sickness over the past month or so. My wife needed 12 trips to the local hospital for treatment. We believe she is healing well, and will be fine, but we would appreciate your prayers that God would continue to strengthen her. Navigating a developing country's medical system is a challenge, especially when you're generally doing it from a place of weakness.

CLAIM came down in early May to help another missionary with their building project, and I was able to take a few men down and join them working on that job. I love construction and am grateful for whenever God gives me the opportunity to use that skill to serve Him.

Best of all, this past Wednesday night, Mr. F, prayed to receive Christ as his personal Saviour. Tomorrow, we're having a baptism service down at the river. There are four people looking to be baptized. Mr. F., another gentleman and two ladies (one is pregnant-this is the only kind of infant baptism we do ;-)) Took Jason down to the river this evening to test it out and make sure we had a deep enough, yet safe spot. He ended up getting his foot caught with a fish hook and stabbed with a sharp piece of bamboo. Must remember to tell the people to wear shoes tomorrow! Will try to remember to take some pictures so we can share the moment with you.
