This year seems to be flying by very quickly! We made it back to Ilulissat on May 5, and we thank the Lord for safe flights and very little issues during our travels.

FURLOUGH

In April, we enjoyed spending some time with Aleah's mom and some of her siblings as well as with Gage's parents. We also finished up meetings in Oklahoma, Kansas, Missouri, Georgia, and Tennessee. We were able to be in a total of 24 different churches during those 3 months, and we want to say thank you again to each of our supporting churches that we were able to visit. We were overwhelmed by your love and encouragement! We also praise the Lord for giving us 3 more supporting churches!

We are pretty well settled back into life here now. The hardest part has probably been adjusting back into a very dry climate and having 24 hours of daylight. However, we are so happy

to be home and able to jump back into helping in the work here.

MINISTRY

Gage has rejoined Brother Chris in the prison outreach ministry. Normally, they meet with the inmates once every other week. But in recent months, the current group of inmates have shown so much more desire and interest that they have begun meeting every week. One of the difficulties with the prison ministry is the constant rotation of inmates. Most of the men are only there for a few months while they await their final sentencing. This gives us only a short time to be a witness to them, but we are praying that the Gospel message they are given would have a long-term impact on their lives!

One young inmate from Venezuela, has especially been encouraging to watch. At first, he did not really talk with us or seem interested in what we were doing, but now he comes faithfully, listens carefully to the Bible messages, and asks questions

afterward. It has been exciting to watch his interest and enthusiasm for the Word of God grow. Please continue to pray for this ministry.

PASSPORT AND VISAS

In August, we will need to begin the process of reapplying for our visas. Lord willing, we will be able to apply for at least a 2-year visa rather than only a 1-year. But to do this, we needed to get Aleah's passport updated or else it would limit the length of our visa. So, a week after we returned, we were able to get her passport application sent out to the US embassy in Copenhagen, Denmark. We expect it to arrive any day now and are praying there are no mistakes in it (which happened previously with Gage's passport). We would appreciate your prayers once again as we prepare to go through this visa renewal process.
