We were able to start our furlough with a graduation, the birth of two grandkids (within five days), and some special times with our kids as well as with our parents. God's timing is always perfect. We tried to get up for furlough last year, but the Lord knew that we needed to be up this year.

In May, we stayed with our two Tennessee girls. Hannah and Elisabeth are living together and working in the same place. They both continue to struggle with health issues (Hannah with severe wheat allergies and Lyme disease, and Elisabeth with Ulcerative Colitis), but they are doing okay. The Lord has helped them with these issues, and they are active serving the Lord despite the difficulties. Thanks for praying for them!

Daniel and his family also live in Powell, TN. He is currently serving on staff at Temple Baptist Church as the head of the Hispanic Ministry. He just finished his Master of Divinity degree at Crown Siminary. He and his wife Emily just had their second child, Katy Jehoshabeth on the 20th of May!



Our son Andrew and his wife Megan are serving the Lord at Freedom Baptist Church in Pennsylvania and are doing well. They just had their first child, Peter Benaiah Goodman! It's a blessing to see them doing well, serving the Lord, and growing as a family.

As I write these lines, we are in Ontario, Canada with my mother-in-law, who is 87 years old. We are enjoying this time taking care of her as my brother-in-law and his family had to be away.
