Update from the Hills in Ireland



We are so appreciative of your prayers for our youth camp. It went extremely well, and several missionary families worked together to make it a great success. One of the highlights was April getting saved. Some of you may remember that about six years ago, one of our church kids, Ashley, died in a car accident, on her way home, after her piano lesson. It was very traumatic of all of us. Her mother remained faithful to the LORD and kept bringing young April to church. She had resisted salvation for years, saying that she would get saved when she was ready. But the LORD was tenderising her, and on Thursday, after several good sermons, she told me she was ready to be saved. After Ashley died, Hannah promised God that she would pray for her sister, April every day to also be saved. It was emotional for her. After she trusted Christ, she asked Jen if they could pray for her dad to be saved. That was exactly what Ashley had said when she got saved about eight years earlier. It was an emotional time.

We now are getting ready for our Holiday Bible Club (VBS). We are using Neighbourhood Bible Time again to run it for us. Running all that just after the youth camp would be a little overwhelming. We have done more advertising and outreach than ever before. We have also advertised in the local primary schools. Please pray with us for a great turn out, that many will be saved, and that we can draw families into the church because of it. We really would appreciate that.
