We want to say thank you all for your prayers as we continue our travels on furlough. Over the last two months we have travelled around 6,462 miles. We have driven through 15 states, stayed in over 11 with meetings in 5 states. Our meetings have included being in both coasts of Canada in the provinces of Ontario and British Columbia.

The month of May started with a conference in VA. We continued our meetings in western MD and the state of PA for most of May. We were blessed to meet up with Mercedes who was a member of the church in Milagro but now lives with her husband in NJ. Finally, we closed May in Ontario Canada at two supporting churches. This was the first time being able to meet in person with these churches as the border was shut down in 2020 which prevented us from visiting them while on deputation.

June began by returning to Tennessee where we were able to have Cecilia's high school graduation ceremony. The day after that we headed out to the west coast where we currently are. As June continued, we were able to visit a number of supporting churches in WA, Oregon and BC Canada. We were privileged to be a part of a VBS in Oregon toward the end of June where we were able to witness many kids accept Christ as savior. The month of June concluded with us being with two supporting churches in British Columbia Canada.

We thank the Lord for His provisions, especially with safety as we enter the summer months of July and August.

Things we are looking toward in July and August are more meetings starting in Washington, then Oregon and finally California by the end of July. In August we wrap up our time on the west coast by visiting a supporting church in AZ. After this we will be heading back to TN for a small break before we continue back in the Midwest and northeast.

Please continue to be in prayer about our need to purchase a new ministry vehicle upon our return to Ecuador early next year. If you would like to take part in helping with the costs of the new car you can send to our mission board with a note referencing the car. As of right now we have been able to save a good percentage but still we lack around \$16,000.

Please be in special prayer for Brother Rafael Ramirez who is a church planter and national pastor in Venezuela. Our church in Ecuador supports the work there in Venezuela which was one of the areas greatly effected by the earthquake. Bro. Ramirez and his family are ok, but others are not.

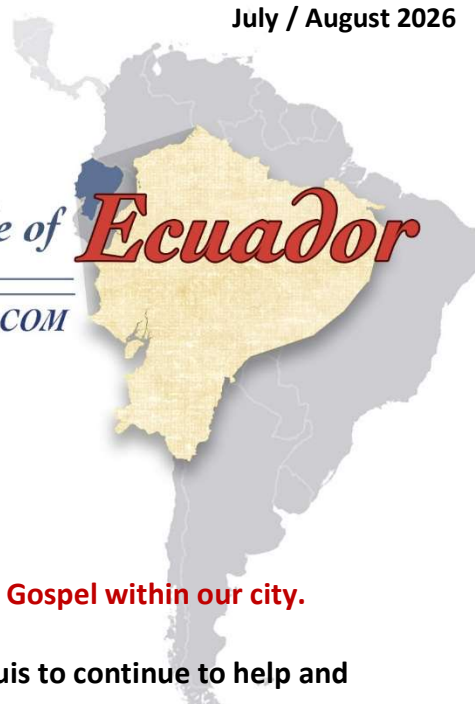
