Dear Pastor and Church family:

June 30, 2026

We send you warm greetings from the Dominican Republic. A friend just reminded me of the wonderful promise we have in Philippians 1:6 – “Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.” I am so very happy that God has worked a great work through and in me through the years. To my loving Saviour be all the glory for all that he hath done! Amen!

Two young men from the Bible Time Ministries, Steven & Juan Daniel, have come to the Dominican Republic to help us with Vacation Bible Time activities for our kids and also our teenagers. They are going around to minister in most of our 15 churches. Last week they were at our church in Quita Sueno. The Lord gave us an average attendance of 225 kids and 70 kids who prayed to receive Christ as Saviour. The last day of our Bible Time in Quita Sueno we received an attack from a 12 year old boy who, the best we can tell, appeared to be demon possessed. He pulled out a knife and blasphemed our church and the name of Jesus. We thank the Lord that we were able to get him out and home safely. The devil was angry because of the 70 souls saved and the 225 kids hearing God’s Word at church. This week they went, along with a few of our workers from Quita Sueno, to our 2 churches on the Haitian border – the Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Loma de Cabrera with Pasto Felo, and the Mount Calvary Baptist Church of Los Carrizales with Pastor Santos. Although they are having the Bible time for the kids, yesterday a 94 year old man was gloriously saved! This morning they had 51 kids in attendance in Loma de Cabrera and 9 decisions for Christ. They will have Bible Time Activities in both churches until Sunday. Next week they will come back and do a Bible Time for the teenagers in Quita Sueno.

Through the years we have had our Vacation Bible Times for the kids in the early summer, and then we have a special meeting for the teenagers. During those 2 special times we look for new kids and teens that the Lord has given us and we try to take as many new ones with us to camp. During camp we preach messages begging God to work in their hearts and in the hearts of all who go to camp. One area we definitely preach on is on God’s call. Jesus told us to pray for laborers for His harvest. We believe God is still calling laborers. Please pray for our camp program this year. So far this year, we are shorter on funds for camp than we have ever been. Camp is \$55 per camper. Box 9, Harrison, TN 37341. Summer Camp.** Most of the pastors pastoring the churches we have started have been called to preach during our Summer Camp.

I have had a lot of different health issues over the last 5 years, but my wife and I believe that the Lord wants us to continue to faithfully serve Him. Last Thursday I was rushed to the hospital with the right side of my body numb. The doctors at the hospital said that they thought I had a mini stroke. I was admitted to the hospital and had many, many tests done. The next day the doctors told me that I have a physical condition that caused a

mimic stroke (with stroke symptoms), but praise the Lord it was not a stroke. We thank the Lord for His goodness and ask that we be able to continue to serve Him as long as He sees fit.

Please pray for our different churches as we finish up the summer and enter into our Fall Bible College classes. We are working toward having live streaming classes to help our churches that are farther away, and even those who are close, but can take the classes easier at their local church facilities. We are trying to do all we can to train young men and women who believe God wants them to serve Him full time. Of course, if we don't have pastors and pastor's wives, there will be no servants who can pastor the churches that we need to start. Please help us in begging in Jesus name that He call laborers into His harvest in the Dominican Republic, and that He help us equip them for the work of the ministry.

Brothers and Sisters, we dearly love you and are so thankful to the Lord for your prayer and financial support of our ministry all of these years. God bless you friends!
