Mission Fields Within the Mission Field

Nairobi is home to people from across Africa and around the world, giving us opportunities to reach the nations without leaving the city. Two groups with little access to faithful gospel witness and healthy churches are the Chinese and Congolese populations.

Reaching Nairobi's Chinese Population

An estimated 50,000 Chinese nationals live in Nairobi. Our church is forming a team to reach them with the gospel. Team members are learning Mandarin and beginning to build friendships.



Recently, the church hosted a weeklong camp offering free English lessons. Through this outreach, the team began developing relationships and creating opportunities for gospel conversations. The long-term goal is to establish a Mandarin-speaking church. Please pray for perseverance in language study, wisdom in building friendships, and open doors to share Christ.

A New Church Among Congolese Refugees

Nairobi is also home to an estimated 64,000 Congolese refugees and asylum seekers who have fled conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Although many are interested in the Bible, there has been a great need for a healthy, doctrinally sound Baptist church among them.

Two years ago, Chantal, a Congolese refugee, was one of Bill's Bible college students. Through her, Bill met her husband, Prosper. Both desired to see their people reached with the gospel. Chantal continued her studies, while Prosper pursued further biblical and pastoral training. We also connected him with a Congolese pastoral intern at our church who offered direction and encouragement.

Prosper has faithfully conducted Bible studies among fellow Congolese. As the group grew, it became evident that there was both a need and a core group ready to establish a church. Prosper has now planted the church and is serving as its pastor.

We praise the Lord for bringing the nations to Nairobi and raising up believers to reach them.
