Dear paying friends and supporters,

We are entering into the new school year here and have seen four new Bible college students join us for the school year. We have classes from Tuesday to Friday, with outreach ministry being all day on Saturday and Sunday. However, throughout the week, God has allowed us to enter into public high schools with our church staff, Bible college students, and volunteer church members. There have recently been some school shootings and mass demonic possessions happening in the public schools here on the island. This has given us an opportunity to start even more campus ministries and class-to-class gospel sharing! However, we are still awaiting some memorandums from the local Department of Education that would authorize us to enter into more schools. Please pray for this door of opportunity, that God would grant us even more access to the schools and that we would see more souls saved.

My wife has been a great blessing, as she has a special ministry of speaking to national pastors' wives and being an encouragement that way. Her spirit and attitude in the ministry are a joy. She was recently able to speak to about 40 pastors' wives and has another speaking engagement for them on the other side of the island this September 14. Please pray for her. It is all by God's grace.

We have another medical mission in Mindanao this coming September 19. We do appreciate the prayers for it, as we will certainly be entertaining hundreds of patients and have another wonderful opportunity to share the gospel with each of them. Please pray for the success of this medical mission and the Lord's provision for it.

We are saddened by the passing of our missions mentor and friend, Dr. Don Sisk. He went home to be with the Lord recently and lived a life that modeled what it truly meant to follow Christ. Dr. Sisk was director for our family when I was a child back in 1991. I later saw him at Bible college, and he was such an encouragement to me at that time. I am sure he didn't know how much the encouraging words he told me meant to me. Later, on my deputation as a single missionary, I was honored to drive him around to different churches and places. Those times of fellowship and conversation about missions and the Christian life will always be cherished. One of the last things he told my wife and I was that was she was an answered prayer for me. He told me many times how I married well, and I strongly agree with him. We need more men like him who will model Christ and show through their lives what missions and Holy Spirit led living is all about.
