Dear friends and fellow laborers,

We have quoted this verse (referencing the sun) many times these past two months! Summers on the Rez are **hot!** We enjoyed finally getting some of the "monsoon rains" a couple weeks ago, even if they did wash out the roads.

This summer was the first that Navajoland Baptist Camp has had two weeks –a junior and a senior week. We could see both spiritual opposition and spiritual victory in both weeks. Junior week, the whole community lost water pressure, among other mishaps; senior week, the guest speaker got in an accident on the second day and had to leave early. But we saw many decisions made for the Lord, and several teens surrendered their lives to the Lord.

July was another very full (and very productive!) month. One of the more unique activities was our Trail Ride. About 35 riders met 10ish miles away, and then rode in. It was so cool to see the first few riders gallop up! After lunch, they heard a clear gospel message and got raffle prizes. Several people came that wouldn't otherwise come to church. Praise the Lord!

This last week, we had a missions group from Great Hope (our sending church) come in. They helped us with a VBS here at Strong Hold, and we also ran a van route to Low Mountain, which will springboard our van route there. It was a blessing to see fruit from our previous outreach in Burnt Corn Valley. We had visited a young man several times, and had witnessed to him. He

didn't come to church, but his sister came and got saved at VBS! Praise the Lord! Besides the VBS, we calculated nearly 600 "man-hours" of work put into the school building. They mudded walls, painted, assembled furniture, laid carpet, did baseboards, painted custom verse art on the wall, and even sorted the school library books!

It has been a good kind of busy these last couple months. Please pray for us as we head into the school season and begin outreach in Low Mountain. We are so grateful for your prayers and support! We received some forwarded mail from some of you and it was an encouragement. Thank you!

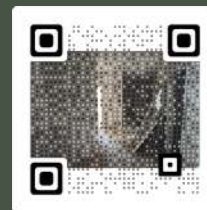
