Dear Pastor and praying friends,

Thank you so much for the prayers and support that allow us to be here serving our Lord. The last couple of months have been extremely busy and rewarding at the same time. We have definitely been pushed and challenged to communicate more effectively over the past several weeks. It is not getting “easier,” but I believe that we are



communicating more clearly. We often get drivers (taxi, Uber) that say our Spanish is really good. No, we don't believe that, but are thankful to be understood more clearly.

June was very busy with a trip to the Amazon where we conducted clinics in Peru and Brazil for several days. We saw God bless with nearly six hundred being seen in the clinics and several professions of faith in Christ. Seeing the difference that compassion makes is truly humbling. I think often of the gospel accounts that record how Christ touched the infirmed as He healed. He did not just make them well, He showed them true love. May we reflect the love of God to those we come in contact with on a daily basis so they realize that there is a God who loves them.



When we returned from the Amazon trip, we helped our church conduct a week of VBS. We had many visitors during this week and it proved to be a great opportunity for outreach as well as to teach the Bible to the local children. It was a busy, but rewarding week seeing the children come faithfully and memorize God's Word. We continue to see visiting families because of the VBS program.

We had the opportunity in July to work with a friend of ours who pastors near Medellin. He was hosting a MMO group who was conducting a free eye clinic for the people in the area. Based on the same principle as the Amazon for Christ trips was the opportunity to offer a physical service in order to minister to the spiritual and share the gospel with those who came to have their eyes checked. All who entered the clinic had someone sit down to witness to them. Many were not that

interested, but several patiently listened, and Kristia and I both had the opportunity to lead people to the Lord that day. May the Lord continue to bless these efforts.

I also had the opportunity to travel to Pitalito in southern Colombia to work with a native pastor and church plant for a few days. A small group from the church in Medellin that we attended during our time

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in the city for language school planned the trip and invited me to come along. We had special services on Friday, Saturday and Sunday while we were there. We had evangelistic outreach a few different times and got to see people saved as we were witnessing in the public park. The pastor there invited me to preach the Sunday afternoon service to the church family. It was a great blessing and opportunity to try to encourage the pastor and his family and be a blessing to the church. I have learned whenever we seek to be a blessing, God always surpasses our efforts, giving us the greater blessing. I am thankful that I have had the opportunity to meet many Colombian pastors and visit their churches. It's exciting to be co-laborers together with Christ.

Please continue to pray for Colombia and the freedom of worship. A conservative president was elected, but as is the case everywhere, there are many challenges to face. We understand that the great need of every person and nation cannot be remedied through political means, but through reaching the spiritual by the truth of God's Word.
