He was surprised to see how well Spirit-filled believers worked together. Later that day he returned with questions, which several church members took time to answer. The project went very well even though we had to work in extreme heat conditions. On our first day of work, one volunteer's shoes delaminated from the heat coming of the roof & he had to go buy new work shoes! Still, there were no complaints. The men were willing to keep working, but the shingles were getting too soft due to the heat & were being damaged. We agreed to begin work earlier in the morning so that we could finish by mid-afternoon. Though our hearts hurt for those suffering in the Canadian Forest fires, we were grateful for the smoke because it blocked out the sun & made it a bit easier for us to

work. We were able to finish ahead of schedule, & went on to strip & shingle a portion of another roof as well as replace some hail-damaged siding.

The church family took such good care of us, & it was evident from the start that the love of God was behind it. The lodging, food & fellowship were awesome & nothing was lacking for tools, materials or helping hands.
